### **Eligibility for scholarships**

- Must be enrolled full-time in a certificate or degree-granting accredited program at a college, university, or technical school for the spring 2026 semester
- The student, the parent/legal guardian, or grandparent must be a member of the Woodstock Milk Producers' Association at the time of application as well as when scholarship is disbursed
- The student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or above on a 4.0 scale, post high school
- Recipients are invited to accept the scholarship at Woodstock Progressive Milk Producers' annual meeting in March or, if the meeting is held via Zoom, to attend the meeting on-line
- The student can receive the scholarship up to a maximum of 4 times

  - o Current resume (including recent work experience, volunteer and leadership involvement)
  - Unofficial transcript from all past and current post-secondary institutions
